PAYMENT OPTIONS - all tuition accounts must be paid on due date

One of these options must be selected for the entire year.

Annual: 1 payment by 15 January 2016

Termly: 4 payments by the first day of each term 12 January, 11 April,
20 July and 10 October 2016. All Grade 12 fees payable over first three terms.

Monthly: 10 equal payments on the 1st of each month from February to November 2016,
by direct debit only. All Grade 12 fees payable from February to September.

LATE PAYMENTS: A late payment charge will be levied at the rate of prime + 2% on all accounts not settled by due date. Annual fees not paid in full by 29 January 2016, termly fees not paid in full by the end of the first week of each term and monthly fees not paid by the 1st day of each month, will be regarded as overdue.

MONTHLY STATEMENTS

The following will appear on monthly statements, and are payable on the first day of each month.

- Text books and workbooks from certain suppliers.
- Individual music tuition fees, payable termly at advertised rates.
- Other special courses, payable as advertised.
- Tickets for school and other events.
- Purchases through the school, such as: uniforms, musical instrument hire, additional printing vouchers etc.
- Additional tuition fees for Immigrant English, Afrikaans and other foreign languages.
- Remedial and other extra lesson fees.
- Fees for any private sport coaching, pottery or other courses are payable termly.
- Outsourced and Bridge House bus transport fees payable termly.
- Dining Hall lunch fees payable termly.

ANNUAL GRADE LEVY

This levy will cover all costs for camps, printing, SMS notification, PA fund, magazine charge and other Olympiad or educational programmes which vary per grade. Please see the web page for the detail of each grade levy.

The following amount will be charged on your January account and is payable on 15 January if fees are paid annually or in three equal payments on first day of each term 15 January, 11 April and 20 July 2016. If tuition fees are paid monthly the amount must be paid in five equal payments and paid in full by 1 June 2016.

All payments received will be applied firstly to interest, fees in lieu of notice, sundry charges and then outstanding tuition fees.
